1. Let affidavit-of-service, as filed in Court, be kept on record.
2. The petitioner is aggrieved that in spite of having all requisite qualifications he was appointed to the post of Assistant Professor. In addition thereto, the petitioner is also aggrieved that the respondent nos. 6 and 7 have been appointed as Assistant Professors, without having requisite qualification.
3. Mr. Chakraborty, learned Advocate appearing for the University, submits that a report is required to be filed in this matter. Let such report be filed by way of an affidavit by April 27, 2026.
4. Since the private respondents are not represented in spite of notice being served on them, the

petitioner is directed to serve a fresh notice on such respondents and file an affidavit-of-service on the returnable date.

5. The respondent University is directed to keep one post of the Assistant Professor vacant in the subject Islamic Studies till May 8, 2026, if not already filled.
6. List this matter for further consideration on May, 8, 2026.
