1. Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. The petitioner has filed the present writ application praying for a direction upon the respondents for taking appropriate steps/action as per the complaint filed by the petitioner dated February 20, 2026; February 27, 2026 and March 4, 2026.
3. The case of the petitioner is that the private respondent is the sister of the petitioner herein but she is suffering from schizophrenia disorder and is continuing medical treatment since the year 2024. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to the schizophrenia disorder, the mother, who is residing with the private respondent, is also facing difficulties along with local residence of the said area. The petitioner has made several requests to the authorities for taking the

private respondent to the concerned psychiatrist for further treatment but nobody has come forward for taking the private respondent for further treatment.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State has filed the report wherein it reveals that on receipt of copy of the writ application, the local police authorities have visited the house of the private respondent and during the enquiry, in presence of the local people, it was found that the respondent No.5 is a mental patient and after her divorce she lives with her mother and the local people also hear the sound of hot altercation from the house of the private respondent. Accordingly, the police authorities have initiated the Habra PS GDE No. 1086 dated March 15, 2026.
5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, this Court finds that before passing any further order, the State has to submit the report with regard to the nearby Government hospital having the facilities of the psychiatric patients. Let the report be filed by April 17, 2026.
6. Let the matter appear on April 17, 2026 under the same heading within five matters.
7. All parties shall act on the serve copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
