1. The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Misc case no. 69 of 2024 arising out of Matrimonial Suit being Mat suit no. 1791 of 2022 from the Court of the learned Fast Track Court V, Barasat, North 24 Parganas to the Court of the learned District Judge, Burdwan, Purba Bardhaman.
2. It is the case of the petitioner/wife that she is residing at Purba Bardhaman along with her child aged 14 years.
3. On the other hand the husband/opposite party is a resident of Baguiati, North 24 Parganas and has filed the Matrimonial suit at Barasat Court, North 24 Parganas.
4. The petitioner/wife now prays that the suit being Matrimonial Suit No. 1791 of 2022 pending in the Court of the learned Fast Track Court V,

Barasat, North 24 Parganas be transferred to the Court of the learned District Judge, Burdwan, Purba Bardhaman.

5. In view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, the revisional application is required to be heard in presence of the opposite party.

6. Petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.

7. Pending hearing of the revisional application under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, the proceedings in Matrimonial Suit No. 1791 of 2022 pending before the Court of the learned Fast Track Court V, Barasat, North 24 Parganas be stayed till 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 or until further order whichever is earlier.

8. Matter to appear in the monthly list of April, 2026 for further hearing.
