Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the additional compensation has been calculated at the rate of 9% per annum on over the market value for nine (9) months whereas the petitioners are entitled to additional compensation at the rate of 12% per annum on the market value (before multiplication with factor) from the last date of publication of notification to the probable date of declaration of the award, which is a little over 12 months.

Faced with such situation, Mr. Mahata, learned Additional Government Pleader seeks time to take instruction.

The Special Land Acquisition Officer, Birbhum is directed to file a report with regard to the dispute raised by

the petitioners, insofar as it relates to computation of additional compensation.

Let such report be filed within 4 weeks from date.
