1. Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. It is alleged on behalf of the petitioner that after a decree was passed on 6th December, 2025 by Civil Court thereby directing the petitioner being defendant in the suit to quit and vacate the suit property in favour of the plaintiff being the private respondent herein within a specified time with the rider that in the event petitioner fails to vacate the suit property liberty was granted to the plaintiff to put the decree into execution.

3. In reference to the complaint dated 10th February, 2026 lodged by the petitioner before Inspector-in-Charge, Bidhannagar North Police Station being respondent no. 3, it is submitted that though cognizable offence was brought to the notice of the concerned police authority, no step was taken.
4. State respondents and private respondents are represented by learned advocates.
5. Learned advocates representing private respondents dispute the submission made on behalf of the petitioner and it is submitted that forcibly petitioner was not evicted from the premises in question. However, it is also brought to the notice of this Court on behalf of private respondents that premises in question was alienated to respondent no. 7 and deed of assignment was registered on 7th February, 2026.
6. Learned advocate representing State respondents has filed a communication dated 28th April, 2026 and same is taken on record.
7. However, on perusal of said communication dated 28th April, 2026, Court is not satisfied with the steps taken by the police authority on receipt of complaint from the petitioner.

8. Inspector-in-Charge, Bidhannagar North Police Station being respondent no. 3 is directed to conduct enquiry and submit further report on the next date.
9. Petitioner is directed to cooperate with the police authority in conducting enquiry.
10. Hearing of this matter stands adjourned.
11. List the matter under the same heading for further consideration on 19th May, 2026.
