1. The petitioner is aggrieved by an order dated December 20, 2025 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Kalyani, Nadia in Misc. Case No.06 of 2025 whereby the petitioner's application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been disposed of by granting *alimony pendente lite* to the petitioner to the tune of Rs.22,000/- per month and a sum of Rs.50,000/- towards litigation costs.
2. The petitioner submits that going by the salary parameters of the opposite party, the petitioner is entitled to a sufficiently enhanced sum and that, the learned Trial Court has committed an error in not appreciating the fact that the opposite party/husband is earning handsomely without any substantial expenditure.
3. The petitioner shall serve a copy of the revisional application along with a notice on the opposite party intimating him that the matter shall be taken up next on April 27, 2026.
