Mr. Roy, learned Public Prosecutor hands over a copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reflecting the withdrawal of an application under Article 32 of the Constitution of India filed at the instance of the de facto complainant.

The de facto complainant appears in person virtually and seeks for eight weeks' time as she has preferred an application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India before Hon'ble Justice Amrita Sinha.

In view of the prayers so advanced on behalf of the de facto complainant, let the revisional application appear on 19th August, 2024 under the same heading.
