1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioners is taken on record.

In the writ petition memo dated 11th August, 2023 of the District Inspector of Schools (SE), Kolkata is questioned whereby concerned District Inspector of Schools (SE) refused to approve the panel forwarded by the school authority. Issue is relating to appointment of six Assistant Teachers in United Missionary Girls' High School.
3. On perusal of the memo dated 11th August, 2023, it appears that the issue involved in this writ petition needs to be decided on exchange of affidavits.
4. Let affidavit-in-opposition to this writ petition be filed by three weeks after ensuing Puja vacation and affidavit-in-reply, thereto if any, be filed by two weeks thereafter.
