1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No.55 of 2019 along with the counter claim pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1<sup>st</sup> Court, Barasat, North 24-Parganas.
2. Mr. Mukherjee, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the opposite parties have instituted a Title Suit No.55 of 2019, *inter alia*, for recovery of money.
3. The petitioner has filed a written statement with counter claim in the said suit for a decree of declaration of title and recovery of khas possession.
4. It is submitted that although the Title Suit had been instituted as far back as in the year 2019 and the petitioner had filed its written statement with counter claim on December 18, 2020, the suit has

not made any substantial progress. It is submitted that the petitioner is deprived of possession of the property that the petitioner had purchased.

5. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, no direction for prior service of a copy of the revisional application along with a notice on the opposite parties is being made, however, the petitioner shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.
6. Having heard learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and having perused the materials on record this revisional application is disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1<sup>st</sup> Court at Barasat, North 24-Parganas to dispose of the Title Suit No.35 of 2019 along with the counter claim as expeditiously as possible but preferably within a period of one year from the next date fixed without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.
