- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 111 of 2025, from the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 1st Court at Durgapur to the Learned Additional District Judge, Alipore, South 24-Parganas.
- 2.** It is the case of the petitioner/wife that she is residing at 27/32, Joy KullaMulla Road, P.O.&P.S.-Thakurpukur, Kolkata- 700063, along with her child aged 8 years.
- 3.** On the other hand the husband/opposite party is a resident of 9A/3/21, Near Water Tank, SEPCO Township, Durgapur(in.cop), District-Paschim Burdwan, Pin- 713205 and at Mondal

para, Kajora, Andal, District-Paschim Burdwan, Pin- 713338 and has filed the Matrimonial suit at Durgapur.

4. The petitioner/wife now prays that the suit being Matrimonial Suit No. 111 of 2025 pending in the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 1st Court at Durgapur be transferred to the Learned Additional District Judge, Alipore, South 24-Parganas.

5. In view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, the revisional application is required to be heard in presence of the opposite party.

6. Accordingly the petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.

7. Pending hearing of the revisional application under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, Matrimonial Suit no. 111 of 2025, pending before the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 1st Court, Durgapur be stayed

till 19th June, 2026 or until further order
whichever is earlier.

8. Matter to appear in the **monthly list of May, 2026** for further hearing.
