- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of MAT Suit no. 111 of 2025 from the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge (1st Court) at Durgapur to the Court of Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Alipore where the petitioner's Matrimonial Suit praying for divorce is pending.
- 2.** On hearing the learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the Matrimonial Suit has been filed in the Court of Learned Additional District Judge (1st Court) at Durgapur

by the husband/opposite party herein.

3. The petitioner/wife herein resides at 27/32, Joy Kulla Mulla Road, P. O. & P. S. – Thakurpukur, Kolkata - 700063 with her minor child of 8 years.
4. Considering the difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Durgapur Court on regular basis, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, directs that Matrimonial Suit No.111 of 2025 be withdrawn from the Court of Learned Additional District Judge (1st Court) at Durgapur and be transferred to the Court of Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Alipore.
5. Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Alipore shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.
6. Keeping in mind the case of the opposite party herein, the learned

Additional District & Sessions Judge,
3rd Court, Alipore shall be at liberty to
permit the opposite party to **appear
virtually**, if such prayer is made.

7. As no affidavits have been called for,
the allegations made in the civil
revision are denied.
8. **CO 991 of 2026 is disposed of.**
9. Parties to act on the server copy of

10. Let a copy of this order be sent to the
concerned Courts for immediate
compliance.
