1. The petitioner was an employee of Eastern Coalfields Limited. A departmental proceeding was initiated against him and he has been dismissed from service by an order of the disciplinary authority. The appellate authority affirmed the said order of dismissal. Assailing the same, the petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226.
2. After hearing the parties, I am of the view, that the writ petition is required to be heard on affidavits. There is hardly any scope for passing any interim order at this stage.
3. The respondents shall file affidavit-in-opposition within eight weeks from date; reply thereto, if any, by a fortnight thereafter.
4. Liberty to mention the writ petition for final hearing on completion of the aforesaid time period.
5. Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to communicate this order to the respondents.
