1. This revisional application is directed against an order dated September 27, 2024 passed by the learned Judge, Commercial Court at Alipore in Title Suit No.03 of 2023 [renumbered as T.S. (Com.) 47 of 2023], whereby the opposite party's application under Order VI Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking amendment of plaint has been allowed.
