It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that, owing to the condition imposed in the bail order dated 23 February 2022 requiring him to reside outside the jurisdiction of North 24 Parganas, he was unable to appear before the Learned Magistrate in connection with the present proceedings under Section 110 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. It appears that, due to the non-appearance of the petitioner, the Learned Magistrate issued a warrant of arrest against him.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be a stay of the warrant of arrest issued against the petitioner vide order dated 12 September 2024 passed by the Learned Special Executive Magistrate, Barrackpore Police Commissionerate, in connection with Noapara Police Station G.D.E. No. 1220 of 2022 dated 22 June 2022 under Section 110 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, arising out of P.R. No. 342 of 2022 and N.G.R. No. 43 of 2022 dated 24 June 2022, pending before the Learned Special Executive Magistrate, Barrackpore Police Commissionerate, North 24 Parganas, for a period of twelve weeks from the date of this order.

Let the petitioner serve a copy of the application upon the opposite parties, intimating them that the matter shall be taken up for hearing after six weeks under the heading “Contested Application.”

The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
