



to remain present in the college where the store is located and a proper inventory of the available instruments and all articles therein shall be made.

6. The petitioner shall be permitted to remain present at the time of inventory. The petitioner is restrained from carrying any third person to the college when the inventory will be conducted.
7. The inventory shall be conducted on and from April 6, 2026 and the same shall continue on day-to-day basis till the entire inventory process and handing over of charge is complete.
8. The matter is made returnable on April 13, 2026.
9. As the respondent authorities are represented by their learned advocate, there is no necessity for giving any further intimation to the Committee members. Learned counsel for the State shall communicate this order to the Committee members.
10. All parties are to act on the basis of the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
11. Certified copy of this order, if applied for, shall be made available to the parties.
