1. The affidavit of service filed today is taken on record.
2. The petitioner no 1 is the college imparting B.Ed. degree amongst others. The grievance of the petitioners stems from an acrimonious relationship with the respondent no. 5. The petitioners claim respondent no. 5 is an erstwhile President having retired in 2016.
3. The respondent no. 5, on the other hand, alleges that he is still continuing as the President and hence entitled to receive all requisite documents including admit cards of 119 students, which has been

uploaded by the University in its portal.

4. Mr. Baidya, learned Advocate appearing for the respondent nos. 1 to 3, submits that all 119 admit cards for B.Ed. course in petitioner no. 1/college has been generated and hard copies thereof cannot be given by the University at present.
5. Mr. Panda, learned Advocate appears for the students, who are the only affected party.
6. Bereft of the fact that there are several acrimonious litigations instituted and pending by and between the petitioners and the respondent no. 5, the well being of the students are of primary importance.
7. To resolve the afore-stated issue, I direct the University to produce a copy (by screen shot) that the admit cards of the 119 students have been generated and uploaded in its portal. I also direct the respondent no. 5 to bring copies of such admit cards duly downloaded from the portal to be handed over to Mr. Panda, appearing for the students, in Court on Friday i.e. March 27, 2026.
8. List this matter under the heading "New Motion" on March 27, 2026 to be taken up at 10.30 a.m.
