1. Affidavit of service, as filed, be kept with the record.
2. The petitioners' grievance is manifold. Bereft of the number of grievances, the issue is an acrimonious relation between the two groups of teachers and/or administrators, ostensibly to take control of the petitioner no. 1.
3. Bereft of this internal squabbling between these groups of teachers and administrators, it is the well-being and welfare of the students, approximately 119 in number, which is of primary importance at this juncture.
4. The issue relates to the issuance of admit cards for such students and certain other documents, along with migration certificates of about 17 students.
5. Since the teachers and administrators are not ad

idem and are lacking consensus regarding the modalities of executing this process, with the consent of all appearing advocates, I am appointing Mr. Sudipto Panda, learned Advocate of this Hon'ble Court, Bar Association No. 13, to act as a Special Officer to conduct and supervise the process for the following Issues and Modalities:

ISSUES

- i) *The handing over of the external application letters to the students.*
- ii) *The marks folio of the students taking the examination.*
- iii) *Attendance Sheets of individual students which will signify their eligibility to take the examination.*
- iv) *The migration certificate which will be given by the students (17) to the University, which will consequentially allow them to have the mark-sheets of the first semester.*

MODALITIES

- i) *The University will intimate to the Special Officer as to the identity of the external examiner, which will in turn be communicated by the learned Special Officer to the students individually. The students will thus be in a position to deposit their requisite papers with such examiner.*
- ii) *The petitioner no. 2 and the respondent no. 5 and all other teachers associated with the College, will ensure that the marks folio of the individual students is handed over to the Special Officer by 02.04.2026.*
- iii) *The Special Officer will hand over marks folio to the Registrar of the University by 07.04.2026.*
- iv) *Upon receipt thereof, the Registrar will issue a receipt signifying the fact that he has been handed over such documents.*
- v) *The Registrar of the University will communicate the result and hand over mark-sheets of the first semester (as and when generated) to the Special Officer by 06.04.2026 which the Special Officer will hand over to the respective students.*

6. The petitioner no. 2, the respondent no. 5 and all

- other concerned teachers of the College will ensure that the attendance sheets of the individual students are handed over to the Special Officer by 02.04.2026. The Special Officer will duly hand over such attendance sheets to the Registrar of the University by 07.04 2026.
7. The Registrar of the University shall communicate the results and hand over the mark sheets of the first semester examination through the Special Officer by April 6, 2026, which the Special Officer will then hand over to the respective students.
 8. In the event the Special Officer requires any further assistance or any documents to ensure that the students are able to sit for the exam, the teachers and administrators of the College including the petitioner no. 2 and the respondent no. 5, will render all cooperation to the learned Special Officer.
 9. On the prayer for Mr. Deb, learned senior Advocate, appearing for the petitioners along with Mr. Chakraborty, learned Advocate the students are required to be added as party-respondents to the proceedings.
 10. Office is directed to cause necessary amendments to the cause title.
 11. It is also important to put on record the fact that 86 Admit Cards of the students have been handed over by Mr. Haque, learned Advocate for the respondent no. 5 to Mr. Subhrangsu Panda, learned Advocate for the added-respondents (students).
 12. Mr. Subhrangsu Panda undertakes to hand over the Admit Cards to the respective students by 10.04.2026.

13. The Special Officer will file a report in a sealed cover on the returnable date.
14. The initial remuneration of the Special Officer is fixed at Rs.1 lakh to be shared equally by petitioner no. 2 and the respondent no. 5.
15. List this matter along with WPA/22624/2022, WPA/27485/2024, WPA/24528/2025 & WPA 25523/2025 for further consideration on 09.04.2026 marked as 02.00 p.m..
