1. Today on behalf of the State respondents a communication dated 2nd July, 2026 of Officer-in-Charge, Ganganapur Police Station, Nadia is filed and same is taken on record.
2. Learned advocates representing the petitioner and State respondents have made submissions.
3. From the submission made on behalf of the State respondents, it appears that concerned police authorities will be required to take steps for initiating investigation taking note of the complaint lodged by the petitioner in terms of the relevant provisions of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

4. Considering the stand taken on behalf of the State respondents, Court finds that opportunity should be granted to the police authorities to take steps in accordance with law.
5. Hearing of this matter stands adjourned.
