1. Mr. Suryaneel Das, learned Additional Government Pleader representing State respondents has filed a communication dated 30th July, 2026 of Officer-in-Charge, Gangnapur Police Station, Nadia and same is taken on record. Copy of the said communication dated 30th July, 2026 is made over to the learned advocate representing petitioner.
2. Learned advocate representing petitioner made submissions on earlier occasion that petitioner belongs to Scheduled Caste community. Therefore, steps are required to be taken based on the complaint made by the petitioner

in terms of relevant provisions of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (hereinafter to as 'said Act of 1989').

3. It is contended on behalf of State respondents in reference to contents of communication dated 30th July, 2026 filed today that on preliminary enquiry taking note of the complaint of petitioner FIR is registered being Gangnapur P.S. Case No. 190 of 2026 dated 25th July, 2026 under Section 351(2) BNS and Section 3(1)(s) of said Act of 1989.
4. It is also disclosed in the communication that Deputy Superintendent of Police (Border) of Ranaghat Police District is entrusted with the responsibility to act as Investigating Officer.
5. In view of aforesaid steps taken by the concerned police authorities it appears that these are in consonance with the relevant provisions of said Act of 1989.
6. Hence, no further order need be passed on this writ petition.
7. Writ petition stands disposed of.
