Affidavits-of-service, filed in Court today, is taken on record.

The acknowledgement receipt issued by the department concerned accepting the *ad valorem* court fees for each of the petitioners in this writ petition is also taken on record.

The petitioners were candidates in the **6th State Level Selection Test – Teachers’ Eligibility Test (TET), 2013 (for short 6th SLST) for the post of Work Education (Pass)**. The petitioners allege severe manipulation in the answer-scripts on the part of the examining authority. The petitioner placed reliance on an order dated August 26, 2022 passed by a coordinate

Bench and prayed for an interim order in the insync therewith.

Mr. Prosenjit Mukherjee, learned counsel appearing for the respondents 3 and 4 submits that from the said order dated August 26, 2022, the Madrasah Service Commission is going to prefer an appeal within a shortwhile. The writ petition **WPA 6548 of 2022** in which the said order dated August 26, 2022 was passed is returnable on September 28, 2022.
