The learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that in spite of a specific direction passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 23rd August, 2024 in WPA 18660 of 2024 directing the Special Officer to take immediate assistance of the Co-operative Audit Directorate to probe into the illegalities, no steps in furtherance thereof has been taken by the Special Officer.

Mr. Sureka, learned advocate appearing for the Director of Co-operative Audit submits that several letters have been issued to the Special Officer but the Special Officer has not replied to the queries raised by the 5th respondent in those letters.

Mr. Roy, learned advocate appears for the Registrar of Co-operative Society and seeks an

accommodation to take instructions as to what steps have been taken by the Special Officer pursuant to the direction passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 23rd August, 2024.

Mr. Nayak, learned advocate appearing for the Co-operative Election Commission submits that further steps for holding of the office bearers election could not be taken as the issue relating to mismanagement and irregularity is yet to be resolved.

Such submission of Mr. Nayak is placed on record.
