The grievance of the petitioner is directed against alleged unlawful creation of security interest by the respondent-bank.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that in view of an advance of Rs.75,00,000/- by the Central Bank of India, collateral security has been created against property, which belongs to a Scheduled Tribe (ST).

On behalf of the respondent-bank, it is submitted that they are yet to receive instructions.

The petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the writ petition on the Advocates appearing on behalf of the respondent-bank. There is a serious question of maintainability of the writ petition, which requires to be addressed.

The pendency of this writ petition will not create any equity in favour of the respondent-Bank and the respondent-Bank is at liberty to

pursue all remedies whether civil or criminal for recovery of their loan in accordance with law.

Let this matter appear on 30th April, 2026.
