1. The petitioners are aggrieved by an order dated February 17, 2026 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) 1st Court, Paschim Medinipore (I/C) in Title Suit no. 691 of 2025 (R) whereby the petitioners prayer for police assistance for implementation of an order granting interim injunction in the nature of status quo over the common suit plots and also restraining the opposite parties from changing the nature, character, status and pattern of usage of the A schedule properties in the suit.
2. It is submitted by the learned advocate appearing for the petitioners that the learned Trial Court has committed a jurisdictional error in not allowing the petitioners application for police help while observing that the petitioners should have filed an application under Order 39 Rule 2A of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
3. The petitioners shall serve a copy of the revisional

application along with a notice on the opposite parties intimating them that the matter shall be taken up next on June 11, 2026.

4. The petitioners shall file affidavit of service to that effect on the returnable date.
