1. Pursuant to the order dated 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2026, a report has been filed by the municipality dated 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2026. As per the aforesaid report, the accumulated garbage had been already cleaned by the municipality conservancy department from the two compartment of the public urinals. According to such report, local people litter and throw garbage around the area which has led to the aforesaid accumulation of garbage, though municipality has been following the procedure of house to house collection of solid waste.
2. Having heard the learned advocates appearing for the respective parties and noting the pathetic stage, I direct the municipal authorities to come up with the appropriate proposal for renovation of the said urinals. It is also made clear that the urinals must be cleaned at least twice a day that

is in the morning and in the evening and adequate precaution should be taken by the municipality so that the same does not lead to any health hazards.

3. The municipality is directed to discharge the responsibilities insofar the removal of garbage and keeping the area clean on day to day basis is concerned, and the aforesaid area should not be permitted to be used by the municipality as a garbage dump by the locals.
4. List this matter in the combined monthly list of August, 2026 when a revised report shall be filed.
