1. Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today be taken on record.
2. In course of hearing, the learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the State, Mr. Madhusudan Sur, submits that the present petitioners had filed an earlier revisional application for quashing of the proceedings being C.R.R. 1448 of 2020.
3. In the said revisional application, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court held that in the opinion of His Lordship, the present revisional application is not a fit case for interference for termination of the proceedings. The said order was passed on 10th May, 2022 in C.R.R. 1448 of 2020.
4. It is submitted by the Counsel for the State that in view of the fact that a second revisional application does not lie and this should be dismissed only on the ground of second revisional application. He prays for bringing the said revisional application to ascertain the actual prayer and

facts of the revisional application for proper disposal of this case.

5. On the other hand, Mr. Sudipto Maitra, the learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners objected the submissions of the learned Counsel for the State and referred a judgment in the case of ***Superintendent and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs, West Bengal – Vs. – Mohan Singh & Ors.*** reported in ***AIR 1975 Supreme Court 1002*** contending, inter alia, that even earlier revisional application disposed of on the ground that there are sufficient materials, subsequent revisional application can be maintainable under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the same may be disposed of on merits.

6. This Court is of the view that it would be better to bring the said revisional application with this revisional application for proper and effective disposal of this revisional application.

7. Let C.R.R. 1448 of 2020 be tagged with this revisional application on the adjourned date.

8. List this matter on ***10th April, 2026*** fairly at the top of the list.

9. Case Diary be produced on the adjourned date.
