1. The grievance of the petitioner is directed against deliberate and intentional inaction of the State respondents in finally disposing of an application under section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (SARFAESI).
2. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that, despite an order for possession having been passed as far as back on 18 August 2025 and the requisite fees for police assistance been paid on 29 January 2026, the concerned police authorities being the Officer-in-Charge, Diamond Harbour Police Station has taken no steps in the matter.
3. *Prima facie*, the inaction of the concerned police authorities is deliberate, intentional and calculated. It is obvious that the police authorities

are acting at the instance of the private borrower and for extraneous considerations.

4. On behalf of the State it is submitted that the concerned police authorities will positively act after 4 May 2026.
5. In view of the above, let this matter appear on 8 May 2026. In the meantime, the concerned police authorities are directed to ensure implementation of the order of possession and file a Report prior to the returnable date.
6. A competent and authorized Officer of the Diamond Harbour Police Station is directed to be present in Court and file a Report enumerating the reasons as to why the order dated 18 August 2025 has not been complied with till date.
