Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner alleges that the authorities have not supplied the information to the petitioner with regard to the status of certain plots of land. Petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the authorities not to damage the land of the petitioner in violation of the provisions of the West Bengal Land Reforms Act; not to interfere in the peaceful possession of the land and to direct the respondent authorities to withdraw their unclean hands from the land and the property of the petitioner by releasing the same.

Petitioner failed to disclose any cause of action.
Petitioner sought for multiple reliefs.

The reliefs prayed for in this writ petition cannot be granted on the vague allegation made in the writ petition.

If the authorities have not supplied information sought for, petitioner has to avail of the recourses available under the relevant statute.

With the above observations, this writ petition stands disposed of.
