1. The affidavit-of-service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. The petitioners claimed to have acquired interest in holding No. 49 and 49/1, Circle 10, Ward No. 10, G. T. Road, East End, under Burdwan municipality, P.S. Burdwan Sadar, District- Purba Burdwan.
3. According to the petitioners, the municipality despite being under an obligation to provide for the drainage and sewerage facilities, has failed to provide adequate facilities.
4. Mr. Mitra, learned senior advocate appearing for the petitioners has drawn attention of this Court to the photograph appearing at page 54 to 56 of the writ petition and would submit that by reason of the failure on the part of the municipal authorities to provide for adequate drainage facilities, the petitioners are suffering immensely. There is also likelihood of health hazards.

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5. Having regard to the above, though the municipality is not represented, I am of the view that the municipality should be directed to carry out an inspection at the locale and file a report before this Court when the matter is taken up next.
6. The petitioners are directed to communicate this order to the respondents intimating that this matter shall be taken up for further consideration under the same heading on 20th May, 2026.
