Being aggrieved by and dissatisfied with the proceeding in GR Case No. 1282 of 2024 arising of the Arambagh Women Police Station Case No. 86 of 2024 dated 30.06.2024, present application has been preferred by the husband and in-laws of the defacto complainant.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that after completion of investigation police has submitted charge-sheet and the charge has also been framed and out of four witnesses two have already been examined.

However, petitioners submit that the instant proceeding has been initiated out of grudge and for retaliation against her husband for not fulfilling her demand of luxurious life.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the application stands admitted.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of application upon the State through the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court Calcutta and upon the opposite party no. 2 through speed post intimating next date of hearing and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.

Let the matter be listed under the heading
“Contested Application” in the monthly list of July, 2026.

However, pendency of the instant application shall
not preclude the trial court to proceed with the trial.
