The petitioner herein has assailed the proceeding being CGR case no. 921 of 2026, presently pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipore.

Being aggrieved by the aforesaid proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations are not supported by any contemporaneous documents and have been manufactured as an afterthought, only after disputes arose regarding the outstanding payment. The petitioner is innocent and no way connected with the alleged offence. Therefore, further continuance of the instant proceeding would be nothing but a mere abuse of process of the court.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the application stands admitted.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the application upon the State through the office of Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the opposite party no. 2 by speed post intimating the next date of hearing and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.

Let the matter appear in the Monthly list of June, 2026 under the heading **“Contested Application”**.

State is directed to produce the case dairy on the date fixed.
