Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.

The respondents are not represented despite service.

The petitioner alleges that the private respondent is raising unauthorised construction without obtaining sanction from the concerned Panchayat.

On prayer of the petitioner, liberty is granted to submit a comprehensive representation before the Pradhan, 3 Amanpur Gram Panchayat, being the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent herein, within a week from date. The 6<sup>th</sup> respondent is directed to consider and dispose of the same within six weeks from the date of receipt thereof upon granting reasonable opportunity of hearing to all concerned including the petitioner and the private respondent, in accordance with law.

The decision taken by the authority shall be communicated to the parties within a week thereof.

In the event the construction raised by the private respondent is found to be illegal/unauthorised, the concerned authority shall take necessary steps in accordance with law.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.

There shall however, be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit is invited, the allegations contained in the petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
