- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the husband/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit No. 165 of 2026, of the Hindu Marriage Act, from the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 2<sup>nd</sup> Court at Serampore, Hooghly to the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 2<sup>nd</sup> Court at Howrah.
- 2.** It is the case of the petitioner/husband that he is residing at 34, Chandra Pathak Lane, P.O.& P.S.- Bally, District- Howrah, Pin- 711201.
- 3.** On the other hand the wife/opposite party is a resident of 43A/1, Kash Bagan Lane, P.O.&P.S.- Serampore, District-Hooghly, Pin-712201.

The petitioner/husband now prays that the suit being Misc.Case No. 165 of 2026 pending in the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 2<sup>nd</sup> Court at Serampore, Hooghly and be transferred to the Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, 2<sup>nd</sup> Court at Howrah, where other proceedings are being attended by the wife/opposite party.
  
5. Accordingly, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, the revisional application is required to be heard in presence of the opposite party.
  
6. Petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
