Prima facie, this Court is of the view that the first investigating officer of the case should have been examined by the prosecution.

In view of the foregoing, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with G.R Case No. 4189 of 2009 under sections 147/148/448/427/323/504/506/120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before the learned 2nd Judicial Magistrate, Barrackpore, for a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date hereof.

Let a copy of the application be served upon the opposite parties, with intimation that the matter shall be taken up for hearing after six weeks. The petitioners shall file an affidavit of service to that effect on the next date of hearing.

List this matter after six weeks under the heading “Contested Application.”
