Mr. Bhattacharyya, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners challenged the Judgement and Order dated 15th March, 2022 passed by the Additional District and Sessions Judge, 5th Court, Malda in Criminal Appeal No. 04 of 2021.

I find that the petitioners have been convicted and sentenced to suffer S.I for a period of four(4) years for offence under Section 420 I.P.C and 6 months for the offence under Sections 419 IPC.

Having regard to the petitioners being in custody, I direct Mr. Bhattacharyya, learned advocate for the petitioners to serve a copy of the revisional application upon Mr. Arijit Ganguly, learned advocate, who ordinarily appears on behalf the State. The appointment of Mr. Arijit Ganguly, learned advocate may be regularized by the concerned authorities in due course.



The petitioners are granted liberty to take out an application for suspension of the sentence so imposed.

Let the lower court records of Additional District and Sessions Judge, 5th Court, Malda and learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Malda be produced and placed before this court on 14th June, 2022 when the revisional application will appear under the heading “**Application**”.

All concerned parties are to act in terms of a copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this court.
