The proceeding under Section 340 of the Criminal Procedure Code is already pending before the learned Magistrate. The present criminal proceeding, initiated at the instance of the complaint lodged by Opposite Party No. 2, appears to be an abuse of process of law.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with A.C.G.R. No. 615 of 2025 arising out of Bansdroni Police Station Case No. 125 of 2025 dated January 28, 2025, corresponding to First Information Report No. 125/2025 under Sections 229/233/236/237/246/61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipore, for a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date hereof.

Let a copy of the application be served upon the opposite parties, with intimation that the matter shall be taken up for hearing after six (6) weeks. The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service to that effect on the next date of hearing.

List the matter after six (6) weeks under the heading
“Contested Application.”
