It appears that the primary grievance of the petitioner regarding the investigation relates to non-seizure of CCTV footage. This aspect has not been considered by the Learned Magistrate while rejecting the “Narazi” petition filed by the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, there should be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with G.R. Case No.4780 of 2025 arising out of Shibpur Police Station Case No.383 of 2025 dated 30.08.2025 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/316(2)/351(2)/348/61(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 25(1B)(a) of the Arms Act pending before the Learned Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Howrah, for a period of 12 weeks from date.

Let the petitioner serve a copy of the application upon the opposite parties intimating that this matter shall be taken up for hearing after six weeks under the heading “Contested Application”.

The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
