It has been alleged in the complaint filed by Opposite Party No. 2 that the property in question had been mortgaged in favour of the petitioners, and that the petitioners, upon refusing to accept repayment of the loan amount from Opposite Party No. 2, caused the property to be recorded in their names.

However, from pages 31 to 38 of the application, it prima facie appears that a sale deed had been executed between the parties.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be a stay of the proceedings in G.R. Case No. 1459 of 2022, corresponding to Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 83 of 2022 dated 14 May 2022, under Sections 468/420/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before the Court of the Learned 3rd Judicial Magistrate at Diamond Harbour, for a period of twelve weeks from the date of this order.

Let this matter be listed after six weeks under the heading "Contested Application."

Let the petitioners serve a copy of the application upon the opposite parties, intimating them that the matter shall be taken up for hearing on the next date fixed.

The State shall produce the case diary on the next date of hearing.
