Leave is granted to the learned Advocate-on-Record of the petitioner to implead the Special Land Acquisition Officer, North 24 Parganas, Barasat, as a party respondent in this writ petition.

Let this amendment in the cause title of the petition be carried out by the learned advocate-on-record of the petitioner, hear and now.

The petitioner claims to be the owner of several plots of land including the LR plot no. 553 within Mouza Malancha, under Police Station of Bijpur, in the District of North 24 Parganas. The petitioner alleges that the petitioner was not allowed to execute a gift deed in respect of the plots in question in favour of her daughter on the ground that the LR plot no. 553 measuring about 11 decimals stood vested to the West Bengal Industrial Development Corporation Limited.

The petitioner alleges that no notice of any acquisition was served either upon the petitioner or her predecessors-in-interest and no compensation amount has

been paid to the petitioner.

The Special Land Acquisition Officer, being the added respondent, is directed to file a report in the form of an affidavit within a period of three weeks from date.

Since the State is represented by Mr. Supratim Dhar, learned Senior Counsel, there is no necessity to serve a fresh copy of this writ petition upon the Special Land Acquisition Officer/the added respondent. However, the learned Advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward an amended cause title of the writ petition to the learned Advocate for the respective parties.
