- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit No. 167 of 2023 pending in the file of the Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, at Haldia to the file of the Learned District Judge, Purba Bardhaman.
- 2.** It is the case of the petitioner/wife that she is residing at Village-Natshal, P.O.- Geonkhali, P.S.- Mahishadal, District-Purba Medinipur, PIN 721603 presently residing at Bhagat, Barabalidanga, P.O.- Shripalli Sadarghat Road, P.S. & District-Purba Bardhaman, PIN-713103.
- 3.** On the other hand the husband/opposite party is a resident of Village-Natshal, P.O.- Geonkhali, P.S.- Mahishadal, District-Purba Medinipur, PIN-721603 has filed the matrimonial suit.
- 4.** The petitioner/wife now prays that the suit being Matrimonial Suit No. 167 of 2023 pending in the file of the Learned Additional District & Sessions

Judge, at Haldia be transferred to the file of the Learned District Judge, Purba Bardhaman.

**5.** Accordingly, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, the revisional application is required to be heard in presence of the opposite party.

**6.** Petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.

**7.** Pending hearing of the revisional application under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, the proceedings in Matrimonial Suit No. 167 of 2023 pending in the file of the Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, at Haldia be stayed till 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 or until further order whichever is earlier.

**8.** Matter to appear in the **Monthly list of June, 2026** for further hearing.
