On prayer of the petitioner, liberty is granted to correct the cause title of the application.

The petitioner seeks quashing of proceedings being C.N. 258 of 2022 pending before the learned 20th Metropolitan Magistrate, Calcutta (presently redesignated as 20th Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta) primarily on the ground that though the petitioner is a resident of Patna, process was issued by the learned Magistrate without complying with Section 202 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. There is an ongoing business transaction between the parties and the allegation against the petitioner is failure to repay an amount of Rs.25,47,795/-.

The matter needs to be heard on merits.

The petitioner is directed to serve copy of the application along with annexure thereto upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service on the adjourned date.

Let the matter appear under the heading 'Contested Application' in the monthly list of November, 2024.

Further proceedings of C.N. 258 of 2022 pending before the learned 20th Metropolitan Magistrate, Calcutta (presently redesignated as 20th Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta) be stayed till 30th November, 2024 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
