It appears that Opposite Party No. 2, as the plaintiff, instituted a suit before the Court of the Civil Judge (Senior Division), 9th Court at Dhanbad, seeking a declaration of her right, title, and interest in respect of the disputed property. However, by a decree dated 1st December, 2023, the Civil Court declared that the de facto complainant had no right, title, or interest in the property described as Item 'A' in Schedule A of the plaint.

By way of the present complaint, Opposite Party No. 2 has alleged that the said property was transferred at the instance of the petitioner without her knowledge or consent. The petitioner and Opposite Party No. 2 are siblings, being brother and sister respectively.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with Bowbazar Police Station Case No. 43 dated 09.02.2022, corresponding to GRNS Case No. 118 of 2022 under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, and 120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, presently pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court,

Calcutta, including the order dated 10th December, 2025, for a further period of twelve weeks from date.

Let a copy of the application, together with a copy of this order, be served upon the opposite parties, with intimation that the matter shall be taken up for hearing after six weeks under the heading "Contested Application."

The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
