In this application petitioners have prayed for quashing of the proceeding in connection with the GR Case No. 4965 of 2025 presently pending before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purba Bardhaman.

Being aggrieved by the aforesaid proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the opposite party 2, has alleged that she left her matrimonial home on 06.03.2025 due to the alleged acts of cruelty. However, the instant criminal proceeding was initiated after a considerable and unexplained delay, which clearly indicates that the allegations were subsequently conceived as an after-thought with an intention to falsely implicate the petitioners and subjecting them to unnecessary harassment through the criminal process. Therefore, further continuance of the impugned proceeding would be a mere abuse of the process of the court.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the application stands admitted.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of application upon the opposite party no. 1/State through

the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the opposite party no. 2 through speed post intimating next date of hearing and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.

Let the matter be listed under the heading "Contested Application" in the monthly list of July, 2026.
