Re: CRAN 1 of 2026

This is an application wherein the petitioners have prayed for extension of the interim order granted by this Court vide order dated 15.05.2026. By the said order, the investigating agency was allowed to proceed with the investigation but as an interim protection as sought for, the investigating agency was directed not to take any coercive step against the petitioners till today.

Mr. Bhattacharya, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners prays for extension of the interim order till the next date, which is opposed by Mr. Majumder, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State, on the ground that the allegations leveled against the petitioners are serious in nature and sufficient materials have also been collected against petitioner no. 1, during investigation.

Having gone through the case diary and having considered the materials collected so far against the

petitioners during investigation, the interim order, which is still in force is extended till 27th May, 2026.

CRAN 1 of 2026 is accordingly disposed of.

Re : CRR 2036 of 2026

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the State, submits that some other criminal proceedings initiated against the petitioner no. 1, is also pending before Writ Court and the next date is fixed before vacation Bench on 26th May, 2026, for further consideration of the said proceedings.

In such view of the matter, let the instant matter be also placed before the Vacation Bench on 26th May, 2026 for further consideration subject to convenience of the Bench.
