In this application, the petitioner has prayed for quashment of the proceeding being G.R. case no. 2338 of 2026, presently pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barrackpore. The FIR refers to an allegation of prolonged physical intimacy with promise of marriage from inception with dishonest intention.

Being aggrieved by the aforesaid proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations made in the complaint are entirely an afterthought and purely intended to give criminal overtone to a failed relationship and therefore further continuance of the impugned proceeding would be nothing but a mere abuse of process of the court. However, during the pendency of the investigation, the parties have amicably settled their dispute and to that extent, they have filed one connected application being CRAN 1 of 2026.

Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 submits that the defacto-complainant does not want to proceed further with the allegations made in the FIR.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the application stands admitted.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the application upon the State through the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta.

Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 also submits that he has already received a copy of the application.

Let the matter appear on 11th June, 2026 under the heading **“To Be Mentioned”**.

State will produce the case diary along with a report in respect of the alleged compromise between the parties on the date fixed.

On the basis of the prayer made by both the parties, let all further proceedings being Baranagar Police Station case no. 106 of 2026 dated 2.4.2026 be stayed till 30th June, 2026 or until further order, whichever is earlier.

Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be given to the parties upon compliance of all requisite formalities.
