The petitioner has challenged the memo dated May 6, 2026 issued by the Secretary of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education thereby directing the President of the Managing Committee of the School to remove the petitioner from the post of Teacher-in-Charge with immediate effect.

Mr. Roy, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that an order of punishment has already been passed in contemplation of a disciplinary proceeding which is impermissible in law.

Mr. Roy, learned advocate for the petitioner further submits that though the memo dated September 8, 2025 issued by the Secretary of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education records that the documents referred to therein has been enclosed but no documents were served upon the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner

thereafter wrote a letter to the Secretary of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education requesting the said authority to furnish such documents and in spite of the same the documents have not been supplied to the petitioner.

Ms. Bhattacharyya, learned advocate representing the Secretary of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education submits that there has been gross suppression of material facts in this writ petition. She submits that the disciplinary proceeding has already been initiated and a charge-sheet has already been issued.

The learned Government Pleader seeks an accommodation to take instruction in this matter.

The learned advocate on record of the petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this writ petition upon a junior of the learned Government Pleader in course of this day.

The petitioner is restrained from tampering with any material evidences.

List this matter on June 16, 2026 under the same heading.
