The supplementary affidavit filed by the learned advocate for the petitioner is taken on record.

Mr. Trivedi, learned senior advocate appearing for the State files a report of the Additional District Magistrate & District Land & Land Reforms Officer, Purba Bardhaman dated May 20, 2026, which is taken on record.

Let a copy of the written instruction be served upon the learned advocate for the petitioner in course of this day.

The petitioner claims to be residing in a premises constructed in L.R. Plot No.1760 within Mouza-Piplaon, J.L. No.105 in the District of Purba Bardhaman.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the respondent authorities are taking steps to demolish the construction made by the petitioner on the said plot of land.

Mr. Trivedi, learned senior advocate for the State submits that a portion of the L.R. Plot No.1760 measuring about 8 decimals stood vested to the State and the remaining portion is recorded in the name of a *raiyat*. From the Records of Rights filed by Mr. Trivedi, it appears that the balance portion measuring about 3 decimals in the aforesaid plot of land has been recorded in the name of one Babulal Kaibartta. From the Record of Rights it appears that the classification of the plot in question as recorded in the Records of Rights is “Doba” meaning thereby a water body.

Mr. Trivedi submits that the said water body has been illegally filled up by the petitioner herein and, thereafter, the construction of a residential house has been made thereupon.

Faced with such situation, the learned advocate for the petitioner seeks an accommodation to take instruction.
