In this application, the petitioners have prayed for quashing of the proceeding being G.R. case no. 4928 of 2022 under Sections 498A/323/325/307/406/506/34 of the IPC read with Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, presently pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barasat.

On 27th November, 2022, the opposite party no. 2 had lodged the FIR against the petitioners on the allegations as stated therein and after making investigation, the Investigation agency has submitted charge-sheet against the petitioners. The opposite party no. 2 herein thereafter filed a protest petition with a prayer for further investigation on 16th September, 2023, which is pending for disposal.

However, it is submitted that in the meantime at the intervention of the well-wishers, good sense prevailed among the parties and they have amicably settled their matrimonial and other disputes and to that extent, they have filed one connected application being CRAN 1 of 2026,

signed by both the parties. Therefore, learned counsel for both petitioner and opposite party no. 2 submits that further continuance of the impugned proceeding would be nothing but a mere abuse of process of the court, since the opposite party no. 2 has decided not to support the imputations alleged in the complaint in view of the aforesaid settlement. Therefore, both the parties have prayed for quashment of the proceeding.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the application stands admitted.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of the application upon the State through the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta.

Learned counsel for the opposite party submits that he has already received a copy of the application.

Let the matter appear on 23rd June, 2026 under the heading **“To Be Mentioned”**.

State is directed to produce the case diary along with a report of alleged settlement on the date fixed.

Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be given to the parties upon compliance of all requisite formalities.
