1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

2. The reasoned order dated 22nd April, 2026 passed by the IG-cum-PCSC/RPF/ER, Kolkata rejecting the prayer of the petitioner for grant of salary on regularization of his period of leave is impugned in the instant writ petition.

3. According to the petitioner, the said order has been passed without providing him an opportunity of hearing.

4. The respondents contend that opportunity of hearing was duly given to the petitioner. After hearing the petitioner, the reasoned order has been passed.

5. The Court is of the opinion that the legality and validity of the impugned order has to be decided upon exchange of affidavits.

6. Let affidavit-in-opposition be prepared and circulated within a period of six weeks from date. Reply, if any, may be filed within a fortnight thereafter.

7. Liberty to mention the matter for hearing immediately on completion of the aforesaid time period.

8. All parties shall act on the basis of a server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
