1. Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.
2. Despite service, the respondents remain unrepresented.
3. The petitioner complains of the municipality setting up/retaining an open vat (large uncovered garbage collecting bin), which is interfering with the ingress and egress to the petitioner's property. It is also the petitioner's case that the aforesaid open garbage bin is causing health hazards.
4. Though the municipality is not represented, however, considering the seriousness of the matter especially with regard to the health risk, I am of the view that the municipality should file a report in the matter. Let such report be filed on or before the matter is taken up next.

5. Let the matter stand over and appear in the Combined Monthly List of June, 2026 under the same heading.
6. The petitioner is directed to communicate this order to the respondents and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.
7. Pendency of the writ petition shall not stand in the way of the municipality from taking corrective steps.
8. The report must disclose photographs of the vat and its proximity to the entrance of the petitioner's premises.
