1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Learned advocate representing the petitioner submits that writ petition was filed since petitioner after declaration of result of Assembly Election, 2026 on 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 was unable to stay at his residence.
